Yet we keep wanting to look in other places. **We can be unaware of the sacredness of where we are.** We overlook the need to go inside ourselves, to seek the God within.

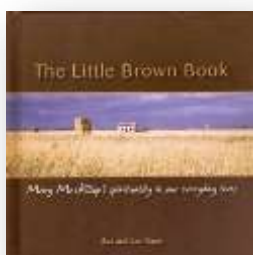
We wait for God to come to us, but, as Mary points out, God is always with us. **It's all about growing in awareness of this.**
